Making and Growing Disciples in Tokyo-to Japan.

Hello Friends and Fellow Image Bearers,

Summary: We are back and adjusted to life and ministry in Japan. We are excited for and working towards getting Shalom House started. We gained a dog and lost a dog.

Our time in Japan started after a 14 hour flight with seven hours waiting to be assigned to a quarantine hotel. It was an easy hotel quarantine. After three days we were able to go to our home for an additional seven days of at-home quarantine.

This meant we could see our dog Blue again! He turned 15 while we were away. We are indebted to neighbors who took care of Blue after the airline canceled all pets in cargo for our flight. They even nursed him through a major infection.

We spent our first month getting set up again. This meant unpacking our house. Most of our things were boxed up in two rooms so our house could be usable for guests. We got our bikes and car ready and re-registered with our city as residents. It took time catching up with ministry contacts, getting reacquainted with our community, and figuring out reassignments to previous roles and job descriptions. The exciting part has been the moments when we look forward to the work that God is doing for Shalom House!

We have had encouraging conversations with people excited for our arts and community ministry, and some who might make excellent additions to our Shalom House team. We have no definite timeline for finding a partner, but we need the partner before we officially launch with a building and classes. We are excited for the work God is doing. We are staying faithful to His instructions so we are prepared when the right partner comes along.

On March 5th we brought home an Australian cattle dog puppy. Nora is a great test of patience, perseverance, and expectations. I am reminded constantly that this is the journey God already had me on as well. It has already provided some great object lessons. Blue died two weeks after Nora arrived. We miss him terribly.

We look forward to continuing this journey with all of you!
