In June of 2021 I suffered a stroke while working on a gazebo for our women's home. It was a longer recovery for me than I wanted. It was well into 2022 before I felt physically and mentally functional. My blood pressure was not well controlled despite medication and lifestyle changes. I needed a sabbatical but could not arrange for one that year. In 2023, it was not something I just wanted any longer, it was altogether necessary to recover my health to continue in ministry.

God provided a dear brother in the Lord, Dave Gorlewski from Flint, Michigan. He came and filled in for the 2 months of sabbatical expected, and for many weeks that unexpectedly followed. Dave was my discipleship partner in a men's program for several years and was invited to camp to be our rifle instructor. That relationship bloomed and Dave became a kids favorite at camp, teaching marksmanship, archery and even axe throwing this past winter camp. Dave Gorlewski clearly had a high work ethic, a love for God and the heart of a teacher with the youth. I felt God leading me to ask him to join our staff team, but I asked him to come and serve for my sabbatical as a kind of trial run.

Dave came and stayed well past a trial. He completed so many physical tasks I was unable to do and rapidly caught our task list up to date while keeping the program going with our young staff and volunteers. He even drove 6 hours to surprise the kids at our Christmas party because he had come to care for the kids so much. In January our Board of Directors extended an official invitation to join our staff full time. Dave accepted God's call and will be putting his home on the market and will be moving here with his wife and daughter and son as soon as circumstances allow. In the mean time he is coming for two weeks a month and staying in a local church parsonage that was opened to him until he can sell his home in Michigan and find housing locally.

Meanwhile, my blood pressure was not well controlled until right before camp the doctors finally found a combination of medications that worked. I was diagnosed with an enlarged heart from years of overwork and high blood pressure. I also needed surgery to remove a damaged section of my colon due to chronic diverticulitis. At camp, I felt so much better with good blood pressure and an excellent team. I got to run a dodgeball tournament and even played along with the kids for the first time in a few years. God's Spirit filled me to preach and many kids came to faith and reconnection to Jesus in the messages. This victory with so many coming to Jesus and a successful camp was so encouraging.

February 22, just 3 days after camp I had my colon surgery. It went much rougher than I understood. God was with me in the pain and the surgery was more necessary and took longer than expected. God sent Dave to head up my Bellwood team at the right time. I have been recovering well and have been preaching again and have been back on "light duty" for about a week now. I can't wait to have Dave back with us for the next two weeks and full time as God provides. My goal is to work with Dave and further mentor him along.

Our youngest staffer has been Colin McFarland who came to us just out of high school to be "kitchen help" when I was alone and recovering from the stroke. Colin has served well and grown a lot. He is now leaving us to follow his new career. We are grateful for his help in due season and pray God's best as he ventures on. God's timing with Dave Gorlewski coming is perfect. Pray for God's provision to financially support another staffer and family taking a step of faith.

Since closing our residential programs last year we lost our garages where we stored camp gear and mowers and snow-blower. We have until fall to move our equipment out and need to build a building we can own to meet our needs. Please ask God how you might help us with this need.
