We've arrived! Exactly 49 hours and 45 minutes from leaving our house in Texas we arrived safe and sound (albeit tired) at a guesthouse in Guinea! We have much to be thankful for: the kids traveled well now that they're older, the airline put us up in a hotel for a few hours during our longest layover (with delicious meal), and our suitcases arrived with us.

We mentioned in our last letter that we were considering a change of ministry locations. Our goal would be for this to just be for a few years. After looking to multiple people for guidance and counsel in this regard, we have decided it would be best for our family at this time. This has been an extremely difficult decision, but we do believe it is what God has for us right now. There are many factors that have gone into this decision and all are complex and not easy to explain in a little update. We are however open to discussing it personally with people.

We will keep you posted more about what a stateside ministry, still with the same mission organization, will look like in another letter. For now, we'd like to ask you to pray for our goals over the next several months while we're in Guinea.

Thankfully we were able to renew our visas today and now we have some other errands to do before heading to our house. We'd appreciate prayer that this all goes smoothly.

- For our co-workers who have had a lot of sickness and other difficulties recently.
- For housebuilding in the B. village (this from previous letters). Pray as they finish the house, and for Cameron as he helps install the solar electric system and update the water pump system to support the added people.
- For our friends and explain to them our plans and for continued opportunities to talk to them about Christ.
- For us as a family, that we will keep our eyes always on Christ, even in the midst of changes and difficulties.

Thank you for praying. It means so much to know we have an army of prayer warriors taking these requests to the One who has power to help. We could not be doing this without the body of Christ working together.

2. VOLUNTEER DINNER & MEETING: Sat., June 8 at 6:30 pm


