Dear Friends and Family,

I am writing to share some exciting things that God is doing in my life this year! I am currently finishing up my senior year at Ross Corners Christian Academy (RCCA). God has blessed me with family members, teachers, friends, pastors and coaches who have had a huge influence in my life. I thank God for the opportunity to play both soccer and basketball at RCCA. Being a part of a team has challenged me as I strive to live for Christ both on and off the court. I am learning how my actions on the court can be a testimony to those watching the game.

This summer, I have the privilege of going on a short-term missions trip to Hungary! Instead of only learning about missions in a classroom, students get to raise support and participate in missions alongside Word of life missionaries. WOL Hungary currently has two major areas of outreach. The first is summer camp, where each summer over 1200 Hungarian young people hear the Gospel. There is also a two-year Bible Institute (a teaching site of Word of Life Bible Institute in NY), with a total enrollment of about 80 students. This trip will focus on summer camp ministry including serving as an instructor in conversational English with Hungarian teenagers, running sports activities, and serving in other behind the scenes tasks. 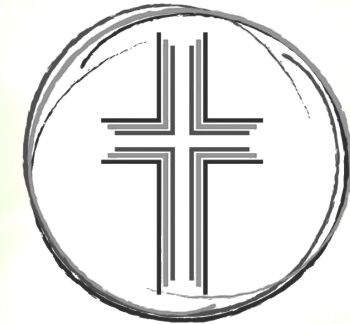
