Philippine Trip - Prayer & Financial Support

Dear Church Family,

June, 2025

It is my privilege for 10 days in August to join with two others from our church, and three from the Dansville Baptist Church in going to be part of a larger team caring for missionary children during a field conference in the Philippines. These families will be coming from all over the world. We will be responsible for the children of all ages during the days while their parents are in meetings. Our group has been assigned to three different child care age groups - I have been assigned to the 4 and 5 year olds. We will be teaching lessons.- like a VBS each day along with playing games, and making crafts, and just spending time with these children. They are children whose lives are different from ours - they face different challenges than we have faced. Part of what they face is a more transient life, and the reality of not being surrounded by their extended family while growing up, and of not living out their life in their passport country. Some of them have parents who are serving in very isolated places - where they don't have many if any American coworkers.

Pray for us as we go, that we will know how to connect and interact with them, loving them well. We are told that they may struggle because people come and go from their lives so often - pray that we can show that we truly care for them. Pray as we present the gospel to them, for some of them may not have yet trusted Christ for saluation.

The volunteers doing this childcare along with us are from around the world as well. Pray for us as we work together with people who don't necessarily speak English, or speak it well, as their role is to minister to children who speak other languages, and that we have cultural awareness and humility.

Pray for us as we prepare to go and as we minister in a very hot and humid place. We are told we will not have air conditioning to help us. Pray we can sleep and have the energy that will be needed for this work.

The cost of our trip is estimated at \$2,301. We have already purchased our airline tickets which are the largest part of our expense (\$1541), we have yet to cover our onsite food and lodging, shuttle service to the location from the airport, and other incidentals that we haven't yet figured out.

I have covered my own costs myself thus far. Once we know more about our lessons, etc. we can let the church know what we might take along from the church to bless the kids.

Thank you for being interested in this work, standing with us in prayer and financial support.

Both kids are accruing driving hours as they work towards their licenses and are working part time for Cameron in his new business.

While the decision to leave Guinea was one of the hardest we've ever made, we do believe we are where God wants us to be right now. The same God who guided us in Africa, is the same God who guides us in the US, and we cling to that unchanging truth.

Thank you to each one of you who has prayed for us, sent us encouraging notes, or financially supported the ministry! We couldn't have done it without you!
